## PLEASE READ THROUGH ALL OF THE INFORMATION ON THIS REGISTRATION FORM!

### A. General Info

This year we had to break up our fall/winter ice into two components. Use the **Pre-Fall registration** form if you would like to skate between September 3 and 26. This is due to the unusual blocks of ice we purchased during the Prospect and Red Wing Training Camps. **Pricing for the fall/winter session** runs from **Monday September 29** through **Wednesday March 11, 2009**.

- Our annual **Ice Show** will be held on **March 13 and 14**. **Dress Rehearsal is on Thursday, March 12 from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m.** All Ice Show skaters are required to participate in dress rehearsal.

### B. Pricing

- Sessions are priced according to the total number of sessions per fall/winter season (i.e. there are 22 Mondays, 21 Wednesdays, etc).
- Low and High Ice Theater include the cost of a coach.

### C. Other Required Fees

1. **USFSA Fee:** This annual fee (\$40) is required if you did NOT pay it with your Summer 2008 registration.
2. **Club Membership Fee:** \$80 (\$20 reduction for each additional family member).
3. **Volunteer Fee:** \$150.00 annually if volunteer hours are not served during the year. (15 volunteer hours required between Sept. 1, 2008 and Aug. 31, 2009)

### D. Other Dates To Put On Your Calendar

- There is **NO SKATING** on the following days: **Oct. 31, Nov. 1, Nov. 26, Nov. 27, Nov 28, Nov. 29, Dec. 22, 2008 through Jan. 3, 2009.**
- The annual **Holiday Exhibition** will be held on **Saturday, December 20<sup>th</sup>** – the **9:30 am general sessions and the 12noon low FS will not be held on December 20.** The synch teams will practice at their regular practice times.

E. We will once again be skating at Howe Arena on the following weekends: **Oct. 17-18; Dec. 5-6, Dec. 12-13, Jan. 9-10, Jan 23-24, Jan. 30-31.**

### F. More Forms to Sign

All skaters and their parents must read and sign the Locker Room Policies and Ice Etiquette forms prior to skating on the Pre-Fall and Fall/Winter sessions.

### G. Session Requirements

**Low Sessions** \* Skaters must have passed Basic Skills 4 up thru Preliminary FS. FS, Moves, and Dance allowed

**Open Sessions** \* Skaters must have passed Basic Skills 4 up through Senior FS. FS, Moves, and Dance allowed

**General Sessions** \* Skaters must have passed Pre-preliminary moves up thru Senior FS. FS, Moves, and Dance allowed.

**High Dance/Moves**\* Skaters must have passed Intermediate Moves or higher and passed Pre-silver dance/working on Silver dance or above. Dance or moves allowed only.

**High Ice Theater** \* Passed Juvenile moves and Preliminary FS by the end of the summer test session, or have permission from Heidi Johnson to enroll in this class. TBSC reserves the right to restructure the levels of Ice Theater to maintain the quality of both the High and Low classes.

**Low Ice Theater** \* passed basic 4 but not yet qualified for high ice theater

## H. Drop-in Ice

1. **Centre Ice drop-ins** will be available every Tuesday from 3:00-3:55, 3:55- 4:50 for \$18.00 per session during our regular schedule for TBSC skaters. There is no registration for these sessions. No partial sessions (you must pay for 1 full session even if you skate only ½) Skaters will not be permitted to skate if they do not have their money. Checks should be made payable to Centre Ice. PLEASE use these sessions as a supplement to TBSC ice, not instead of.
2. **TBSC Drop-ins** will begin during our regular fall/winter session and will be at \$21.00/hour.

**I. Lockers** will be available for \$50 per year to Hi/Lo skaters. If you do not rent a locker you will need to take your skates and miscellaneous items home each day you skate.

**J. Registration** will take place on Monday, August 25 5:30pm to 6:30pm **If you are unable to attend registration on August 25<sup>th</sup>, be sure to contact Cathy Shoemaker or Judy Tilford prior to the 25<sup>th</sup> to make alternative arrangements and to avoid the late registration fee (\$40).**

**Please note:** The fall/winter schedule begins with a **3pm to 3:40pm** session each day. Due to our continuing financial challenges and projected budget deficit, it is imperative that we have enough skaters registered on these sessions to be able to pay the ice bill for that ice. If there is not sufficient registration for any of the 3pm sessions we will need to drop the under-registered session(s). The decision to keep or drop the 3pm sessions will be made at the October 14 Board meeting. Therefore, if you plan to register for any 3pm sessions, please be sure to do so well-before **October 14.**

## K. Payments

Payments are to be made by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month **exception is the final payment in March is due by March 2<sup>nd</sup>.** Skaters with a past due account **will not be allowed** to skate until their account is made current. **Don't forget that we now accept Master Card and Visa in the office.** Bills will be emailed monthly. TBSC will charge a late fee for accounts over 15 days past due.

**Any skater whose account is not paid off before March 2 will not receive their ice show costume and will not be permitted to participate in the Ice Show.** Families needing exceptions to this policy must address the TBSC Board in a closed meeting. If a skater must forfeit their participation in the ice show, no refunds will be made by TBSC and the Club will take the necessary action to collect the money due unless a special circumstance is determined by the board.

Comment from the treasurer on payments. Club payments need to be made on a timely basis, and if you make additional payments or participate in any fundraising events these payments will be applied to your final payment. For example, if your total Fall bill is \$980/7 payments your monthly payment would be \$140.00. If you were to pay \$500.00 in month one you would still be responsible for paying \$140.00 for your month 2 payment and not have to pay your final payment. It is imperative that we have enough money in the club account to meet our current obligations. If you have any questions or concerns please see Cathy.
